Minutes:

Business Arising:

General Business:

Grading System:

Mark Davis from MGPS has suggested that the grading system needs to be reviewed and suggested that the entrants grading should be in line with their grading at the entrants own club.

After much debate the delegates proposed that the following be put to the participating clubs and the rules be amended according if ratified by the clubs:

Entrants First Entry	Grading determined by the entrants own club.
Upon obtaining a Placing	Upon a entrant graded "B" obtaining a placing in the Interclub AV Competition, they be promoted to "A" grade for the competition in the following year.

Host Club – 2010: ASPLEY

Delegates at the meeting advised that their club was prepared to host the competition in 2010.

Competition Dates:

It was again suggested that the competition be held in September next year.

Presentation Equipment:

Barry Beckham from Noosa raised the issue of laptops being used to present the AV's. Barry advised that animations cannot be run properly on a laptop & suggested that as the competition is a once a year event, that use of a desktop machine would be better. Most delegates advised that the club used laptops at their club and that the reasons for playback problems could be due to many other reasons.

File Size:

Again this year saw quite a variance in file sizes. Discussion recommended that it be suggested to entrants that they should where possible use Q12 sized images for all images in their AV's.

Removal of Reference to SSS:

Betty Hazeldean moved a motion that all references to "SSS" be removed from the competition rules (12 & 13).
